Things were going well for Sarah Scantlin. She was a freshman in college, got a good job in a local store, made the college cheerleading team – she was on her way. She went out to celebrate one night and on her way home got hit by a drunk driver who car pushed hers into the path of another oncoming vehicle.

She was rushed to the hospital, but her situation was critical. Her skull was crushed, her leg horribly twisted and she fell into a coma. The year was 1985.

For two decades all Scantlin could do was breathe on her own. Doctors said they would never talk to her again.

Eventually she was taught her to blink once for 'yes' and twice for 'no' but her responses were very slow and they questioned whether she understood anything.

Fast forward to Valentine's Day, 2005. A call came from the care home where Sarah was and her mother answered.

"Hi mom," said a husky voice.

"Sarah, is that you?" Scantlin's mother Betsy asked.

"Yes."

"How are you doing?"

"Fine."

"Do you need anything?" her mother asked.

"More makeup."

"Did she just say more makeup?" Betsy asked incredulously.

That was just the *beginning* of Scantlin's totally bizarre recovery.

Sarah had actually begun talking in January but waited until February to begin talking to her mom. The thought is that, given time, Scantlin's brain repaired itself enough for her to talk.

The amazing thing was, however, that even though Sarah could not talk all that time, she could hear. She knew a little bit about the outside world through the TV that was on, and through conversations she overheard.

She was listening the whole time.

If someone who never spoke for twenty years could hear everything you said in those years, what would they have learned? About you? About others? About God?

You may not realize it, but people are listening to us all the time. Matthew 12:37 says, **For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned.**" Sure our children, and our spouses...but also our neighbors and store clerks and hairdressers – they listen, too. Be careful what you say. It reveals what is in your heart!
