IT IS A BIG DEAL

One of the biggest mistakes we make as believers is to judge our sin to be no big deal. Others sin a lot worse than we do. Murder, lies, stealing, adultery – if we haven't done any of those things, we really aren't all that bad.

Wrong!

Sin – all sin is an affront to our holy God. Purity is marred by the least “little” sin. It was our sin that put Christ on the cross.

Stuart Townend wrote a powerful song that we've sung in our church. Let the lyrics speak to your soul today:

*How deep the Father's love for us, How vast beyond all measure,
That He should give His only Son To make a wretch His treasure.
How great the pain of searing loss - The Father turns His face
away,
As wounds which mar the Chosen One. Bring many sons to
glory.*

*Behold the man upon a cross, My sin upon His shoulders;
Ashamed, I hear my mocking voice Call out among the scoffers.
It was my sin that held Him there Until it was accomplished;
His dying breath has brought me life - I know that it is finished.*

*I will not boast in anything, No gifts, no power, no wisdom;
But I will boast in Jesus Christ, His death and resurrection.
Why should I gain from His reward? I cannot give an answer;
But this I know with all my heart - His wounds have paid my
ransom.*
