Certainly one of Jesus' most accusatory and inflaming statements was the one he made to religious leaders.

Matthew 23:27,28 says, "*Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean. ²⁸ In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness.*"

In those days tombs were painted white so that people might avoid them in the dark of night, thus making them ceremonially unclean. Jesus said plainly to these people that, on the outside, they looked good and righteous, but on the inside they were full of death and decay.

Ouch!

It is amazing how we focus on the things we see, but not on the heart. People are more worried about what the outside of the church looks and how we present to others, than what the inside of our hearts look like and how we present to God. God is **always** more concerned with what's inside.

I Samuel 16:7 says, "*The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.*"

What is going on inside **your** heart, today? Do you love Jesus? Is your heart filled with praise, or pride? Others can always tell because the Bible says, **For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of** (Luke 6:45). So, no matter how much you gussy up the outside, be careful. Your insides – the TRUE YOU – is showing!

But Jesus did not talk like this just to embarrass people. He can cleanse the leper and the gossip! Praise God!
